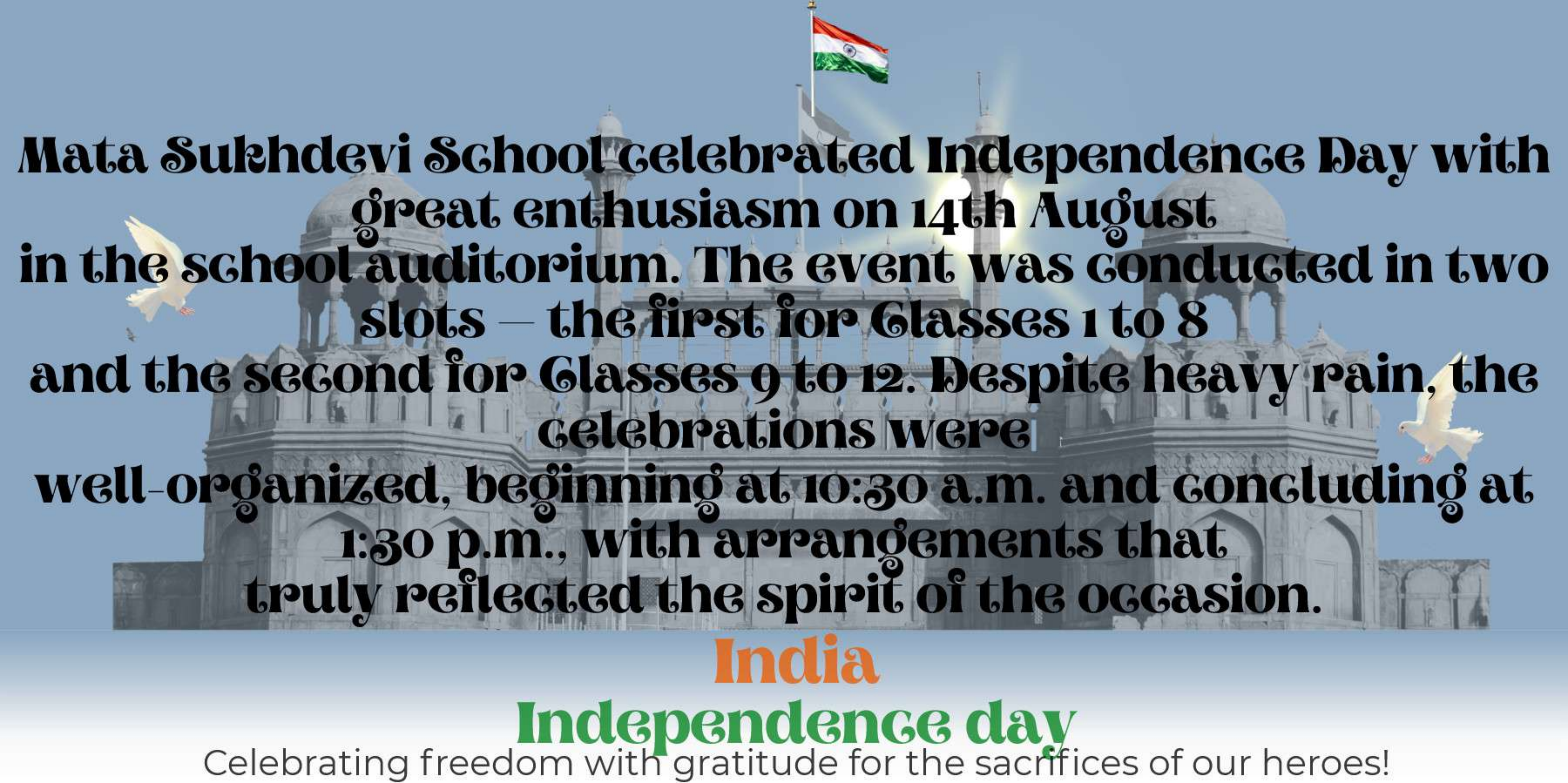

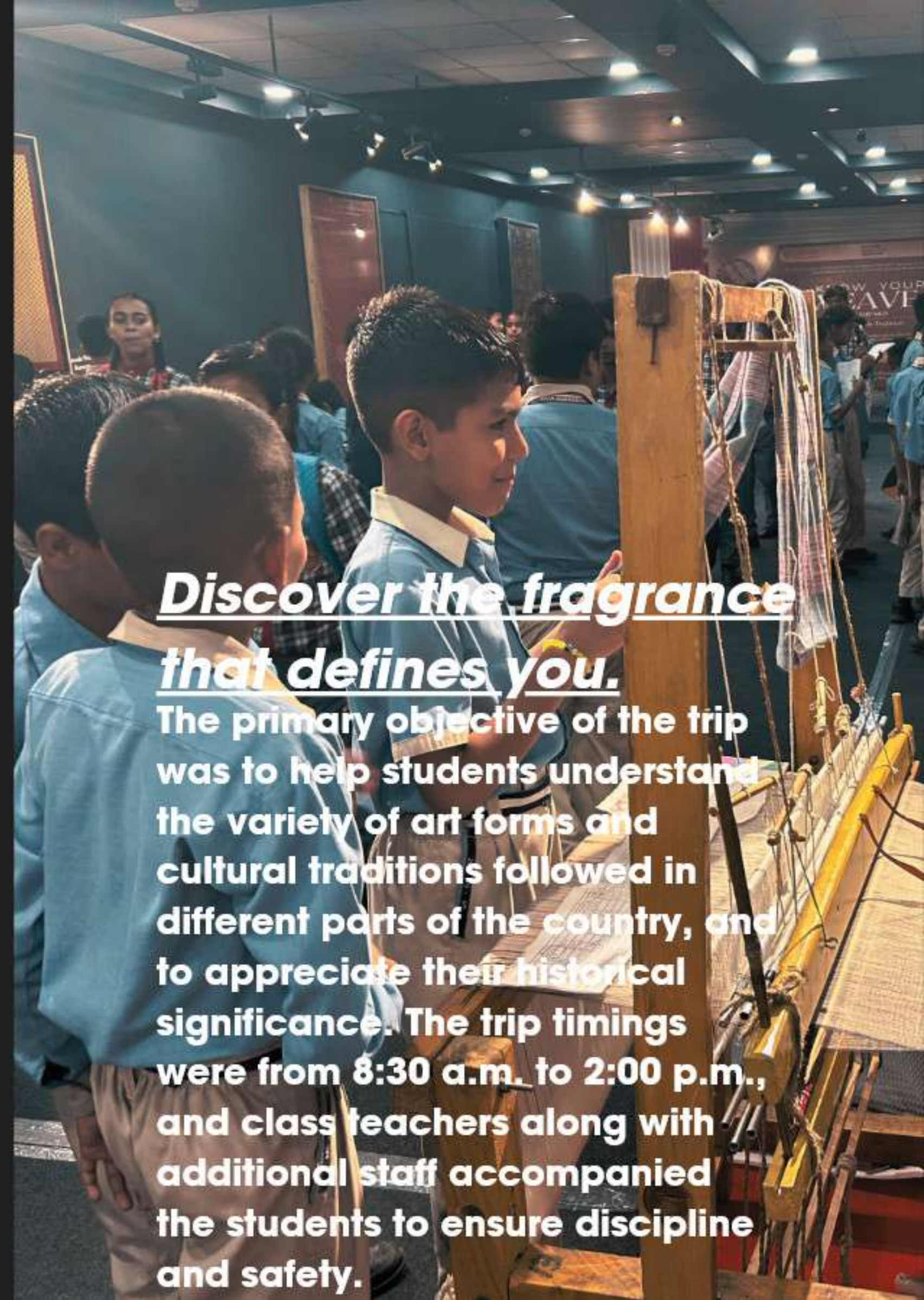

नवाब राधनपुर के महल से प्राप्त लकड़ी का नक्काशीदार झरोखा, उत्तरी गुजरात। 18 वीं सदी का उत्तरार्द्ध।

झरोखा, दीवार से बाहर निकला हुआ रहता है। यह घेरेदार टेबो पर टिका रहता है जो नीचे एक बिन्दु पर मिलती हैं। यहाँ यह बिन्दु हाथी के सिर के रूप में है। साथ के झरोखे शाही परिवार के अन्य सदस्यों के लिए होते थे। जबकि जालियों से रिकवा तो बाहर देख सकती थी, उन्हें बाहर से नहीं देखा जा सकता था।

फोटोग्राफ में झरोखा अपनी वास्तविक स्थिति में दर्शाया गया है।

Carved wooden jharokha (balcony) from the Palace of the nawab of Radhanpur, North Gujarat. Late 18th Century.

The palace jharokha is cantilevered from the wall and is supported by a circle of struts starting from a common point below: in this case, an elephant head, which is not clearly visible here. The accompanying jharokhas were meant for other members of the royal family, while the pierced screens ensured that women could look out without being seen. The above photograph shows the jharokha in situ.
